

# ELECTRONIC RECYCLING OPTIONS

## RETAIL DROP OFF

**Best Buy-** Best Buy will accept up to three items per household per day. They will accept nearly all electronic items, including tube TVs and monitors up to 32", flat panel TV's up to 60", computers, peripherals, DVD players, home and car audio, cell phones, MP3 players, and cables. A haul away program is available for console TV's of any size, tube TV's and monitors larger than 32". There is a charge for the haul away program. Details can be found at [www.bestbuy.com/recycling](http://www.bestbuy.com/recycling).

**Hewlett Packard-** Hewlett Packard accepts many electronic items through an on-line, consumer buyback and recycling mail program. They will accept many types of computer equipment, including monitors, printers, and scanners; smartphones, digital cameras and PDAs. There are no shipping charges for HP, Compaq and Palm products when they are recycled. Details are available at [www.hp.com/recycle](http://www.hp.com/recycle).

**Dell Computer-** In addition to its Reconnect Program partnership with Goodwill Industries, Dell offers a free, at home pickup program for any Dell product and non-Dell branded product (with the purchase of a similar type of Dell product). **Staples-** Staples will accept up to six items per household per day. They will accept working electronic devices including computers, monitors and many peripherals. There is a \$10 fee to accept monitors, printers, desktop copiers, scanners, faxes and all-in-ones. They do not accept TV's, floor model copiers, home or car audio or monitors with cracked screens. They also offer a free on-line, pre-paid mail program that accepts many working electronic items. Details are available at [www.staples.gazelle.com](http://www.staples.gazelle.com).

**Office Depot-** Office Depot accepts many electronic items at its stores through its Tech Recycling Box program. They will accept computer equipment, including monitors, printers, scanners, faxes, and all-in-ones, small TV's, cell phones, DVD and MP3 players, and cables. They do not accept monitors with cracked screens. Three sizes of boxes are available at a cost of \$5, \$10 or \$15 each. Details are available at [www.officedepot.com](http://www.officedepot.com).
