## UNINCORPORATED MAINE TOWNSHIP MANDATORY SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING COLLECTION PROGRAM

Maine Township recently went out to bid for an Exclusive Solid Waste and Recycling Franchise for single-family residential buildings and multi-family residential buildings of eight (8) or less units located in the unincorporated area of Maine Township ("Service Area"). On March 22, 2016, Ordinance No. 2016-1 was adopted by the Supervisor and Board of Trustees awarding Allied Waste Services of North America, Inc., d/b/a Republic Services ("Republic"), an Exclusive Solid Waste and Recycling Franchise for the Service Area for a five year term commencing on April 1, 2016, and continuing until March 31, 2021, unless otherwise terminated or extended pursuant to an Agreement between the Township and Republic Services.

## SENIOR CITIZEN DISCOUNT

Maine Township Residents who are Senior Citizens can now receive a discount by providing copies of the following documents to Republic:

- 1. **Evidence that the Resident is 65 Years of Age or Older**: Proof of age shall be in the form of a valid state-issued driver's license or identification card, or birth certificate or U.S. passport; and
- 2. **Evidence of Residency**: A copy of a current property tax bill showing that the resident is the owner of the residential dwelling for which he/she/they are seeking the Senior Citizen's Discount.

## OWNER/LANDLORD REQUIREMENT

Included in the aforesaid Ordinance No. 2016-1 is a requirement that all owners who lease out their residential dwellings must maintain the account with Republic Services in his/her/their own name.

Each month for which an owner shall fail to maintain an account, as required under the Ordinance, shall be deemed a separate offense and shall be subject to a fine.
