**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUPERVISOR TO
TAKE CERTAIN ACTIONS WHEN EMPLOYEES
ARE DIAGNOSED WITH COVID-19**

WHEREAS, Maine Township is an Illinois public entity operating under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Township is a unit of local government established and governed by the Illinois Township Code, 60 ILCS 1/1-1, *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the nation is experiencing the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, at times, employees test positive for COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board seeks to establish procedures and protocols to keep employees and patrons safe and to prevent the transmission of COVID-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE SUPERVISOR AND TOWNSHIP BOARD OF MAINE TOWNSHIP, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: When two or more Maine Township or Maine Township Road District employees test positive for the COVID-19 virus, the Township Supervisor is hereby authorized to close impacted Township and/or Road District buildings or facilities and to have all necessary Township and/or Road District facilities where the employees have worked or been present deep-cleaned prior to returning employees to work.

SECTION 2: When the Supervisor orders such closures as specified in Section 1, Township and/or Road District employees shall not work from any closed buildings or facilities until such have been deep cleaned and shall work remotely, if possible. If the employee is

unable to work remotely because of that employee's job duties or for any other reason, the Supervisor will review applicable options with the Township Attorney.

SECTION 3: If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 4: All Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
