Supervisor Dimond stated that a tentative 2022-2023 Road District Budget was available to the public for 30 days and a legal notice was published in regards to the Road District's Budget Hearing.

Highway Commissioner Beauvais stated that the Road District Budget 2022-2023 that has been distributed tonight it is the final one. This balanced budget went up approximately \$200,000 from tentative budget and it will not be an extra burden to our taxpayers. Highway Commissioner Beauvais mentioned that the biggest challenge was preparing for what is happening in the world because of the oil prices. He said that his budget will have to be evaluated in six months to see where the Highway Department stands financially.
